This is with reference to the Standard Administrative Arrangement (SAA) signed between the Government of Iceland and the United Nations Population Fund in October 2011 relating to a contribution towards the UNFPA/UNICEF Joint Programme to "Accelerate the Abandonment of Female Genital Mutilation/Cutting (FGM/C)".

Article 1, para 1 of the said Agreement (enclosed herewith as Annex 1) confirmed the decision of the Government of Iceland to make a contribution of 24 million ISK and "such further amounts as it may decide (hereinafter referred to as the "Contribution") to support the Programme".

It has been agreed by the Government of Iceland to contribute an additional \$US 100,000 (one hundred thousand dollars) towards the Programme upon signature of this amendment agreement by both Parties.

It should further be noted that the duration of the Joint Programme was extended to 31 December 2013 based on a decision by the Joint Programme Steering Committee on 9 July 2011, which includes the Government of Iceland as a member. All other terms and conditions as stipulated in the SAA signed in October 2011 shall continue to apply.
