

**Addendum #3 to the Standard Administrative Arrangement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, acting through the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO), and UNFPA concerning “UNFPA-UNICEF Joint Programme to Eliminate Female Genital Mutilation: Delivering the Global Promise to End FGM by 2030”**

WHEREAS FCDO and UNFPA (jointly referred to as the Parties) have entered into an agreement dated 9 March 2023 (the Agreement) concerning [UNFPA-UNICEF Joint Programme on the Elimination of Female Genital Mutilation: Delivering the Global Promise to End FGM by 2030] (the Joint Programme);

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended by written agreement between the Parties via Addendums 1 and 2 signed on 28 February 2024 and 12 June 2024 respectively;

NOW THEREFORE the Parties have reached the following understanding, which shall constitute Addendum #3 to, and be an integrated part of, the Agreement:

## **1 ADDITIONAL GRANT**

- 1.1 FCDO will provide an additional contribution of GBP 850,000 (eight hundred fifty thousand British pound sterling) (the Additional Grant) to the Joint Programme.
- 1.2 The Additional Grant shall be paid upon signing of this Addendum.

## **2 REMAINING CONDITIONS OF THE AGREEMENT**

- 2.1 All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in force.

## **3 ENTRY INTO FORCE AND DURATION**

- 3.1 The Addendum shall enter into force on the date of the last signature.
