Addendum number 2 to the agreement between Sweden, represented by the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida) and UNFPA concerning "UNFPA-UNICEF Joint Programme To Eliminate Female Genital Mutilation: Delivering the Global Promise To End FGM"

WHEREAS, Participating United Nations Organizations that have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "<u>Participating UN Organizations</u>") have developed the UNFPA-UNICEF Joint Programme to Eliminate Female Genital Mutilation:

Delivering the Global Promise to end FGM (hereinafter referred to as the "<u>Programme</u>") starting on 1 January 2022 and ending on 31 December 2030 (hereinafter "<u>End Date</u>");

WHEREAS, UNFPA, acting as "Administrative Agent" for the Participating UN Organisations and Donor concluded a Standard Administrative Arrangement with effect from 1 January 2022 ("SAA") regarding Donor's financial contribution to the Programme;

WHEREAS, Section 1 (Disbursement of Funds to the Administrative Agent and the Programme Account) and Annex B (Schedule of Payments) of the above mentioned SAA shall be amended as follows;


NOW THEREFORE, the Donor and the Administrative Agent ("Participants") hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Further to the SAA, signed on 5 December 2022, and amended on 20 November 2023, revise the SAA contribution total figure in Section I, No 1 from SEK 190,000,000 (Million Swedish Kronor) to SEK 365,000,000 (Million Swedish kronor).
- 2. An additional amount of SEK 100,000,000 (Million Swedish Kronor) will be added to the payment Schedule in Annex B; Schedule of Payments, with SEK 60,000,000 to be disbursed upon signature and SEK 40,000,000 to be disbursed on 1 February 2026.
- 3. All other terms of the SAA shall remain unchanged.
