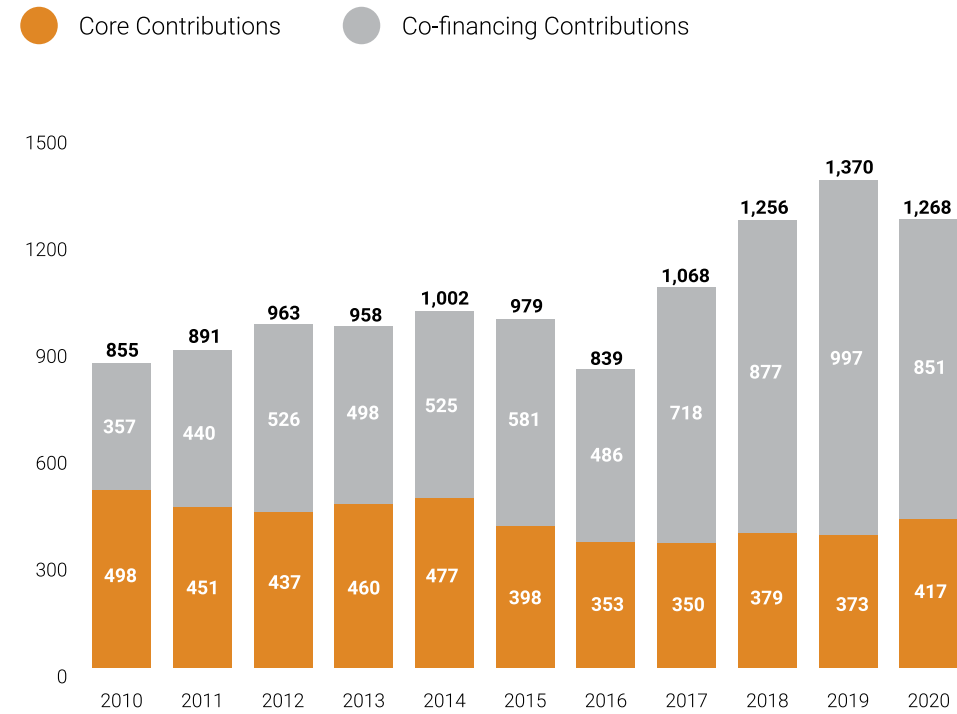

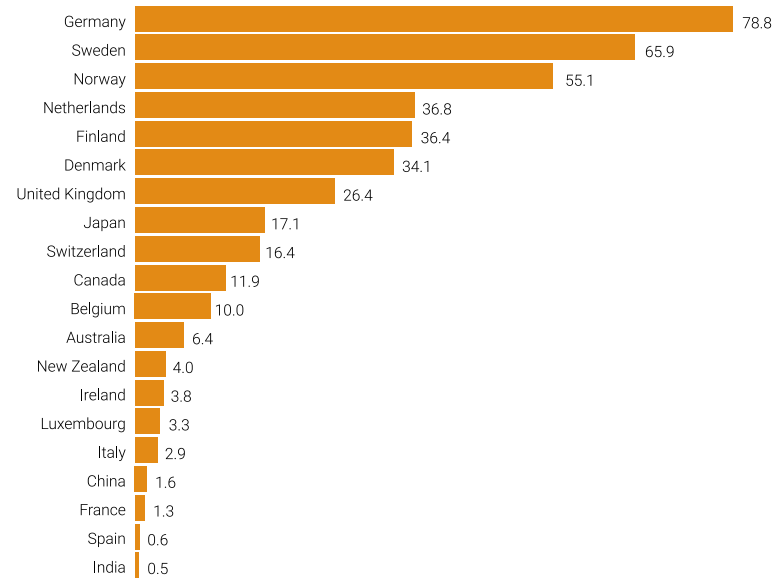

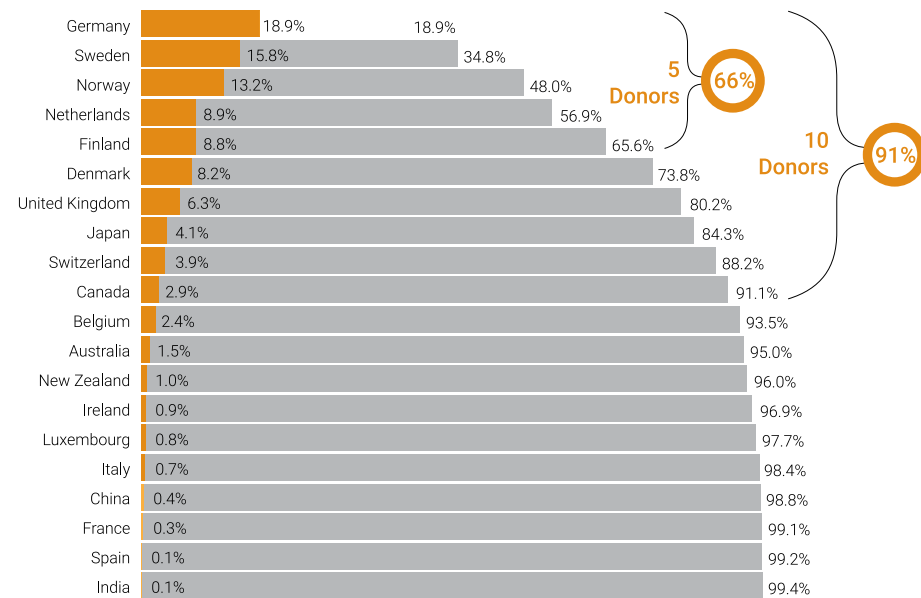

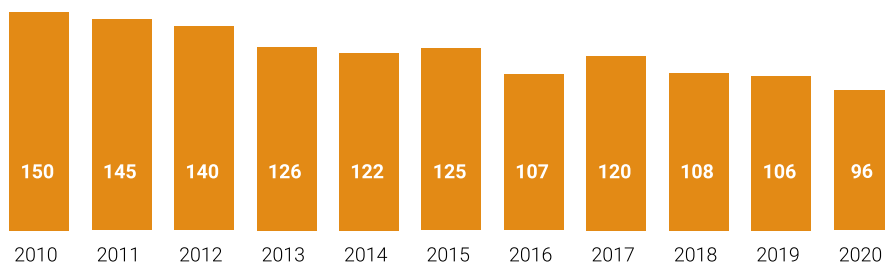
## Top 20 Donor Contributions to Core Resources (MILLIONS OF US\$)



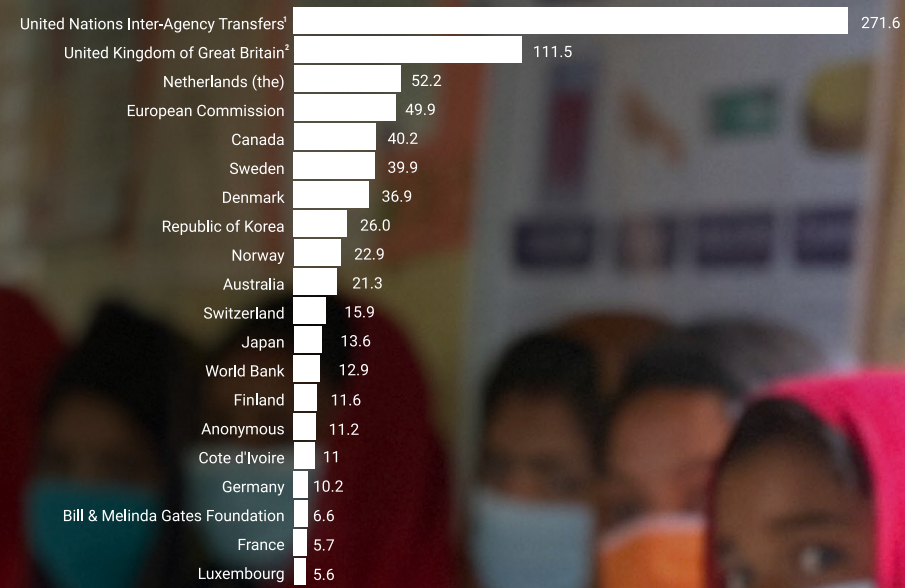
## Cumulative Percentage Share of Top 20 Donors to Total Core Contributions: \$417 million



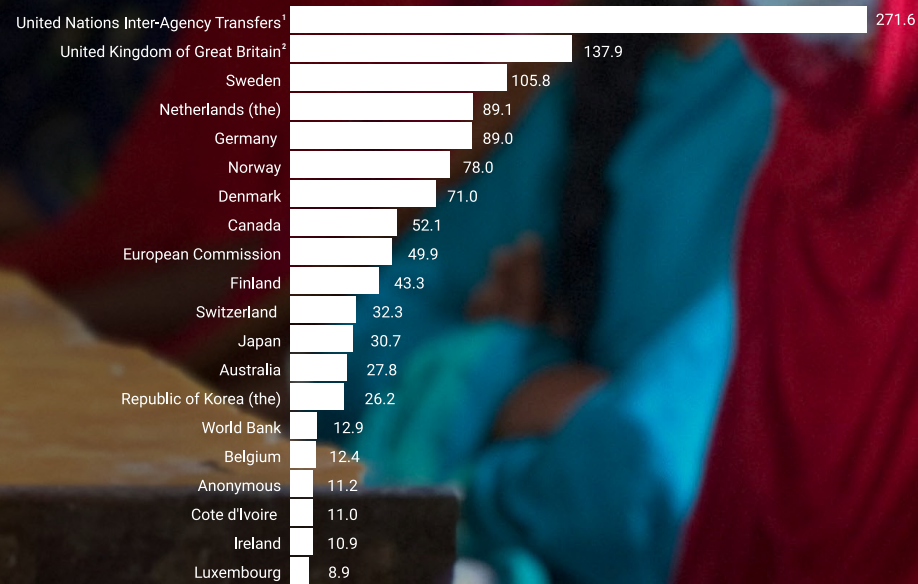
## Number of Donor Governments That Have Contributed to UNFPA's Core Resources
