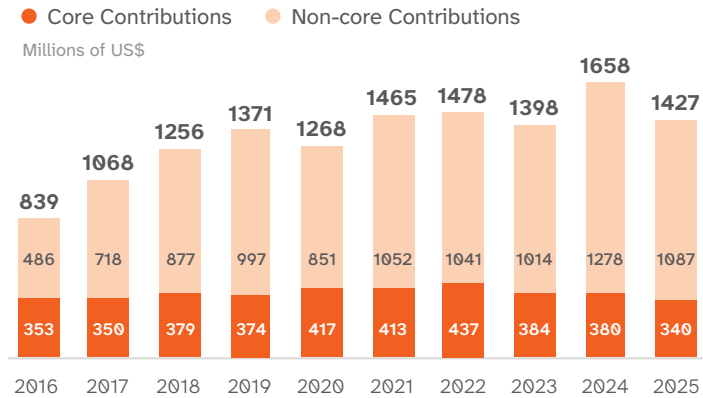


UNFPA, the United Nations Population Fund, is the sexual and reproductive health agency of the UN. It works to uphold the rights and choices of women, girls and young people across more than 150 countries. UNFPA aims to ensure that every pregnancy is wanted, every childbirth is safe, and every young person can fulfil their potential. It also helps governments plan for changing demographics, to build inclusive and resilient societies. UNFPA relies on both core and non-core resources to fulfil its mandate.

Sustaining a solid core funding base and a favourable balance between core and non-core resources is crucial for conducting our work in complex environments and for responding to unforeseen challenges. In 2025, core contributions to UNFPA accounted for 24 per cent of its funding. The UN Global Funding Compact’s target of reaching 30 per cent in core resources would ensure greater predictability, flexibility and agility needed to deliver impactful responses on the ground.

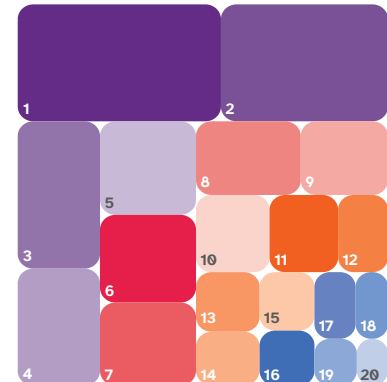


Core and non-core contributions 2016-2025

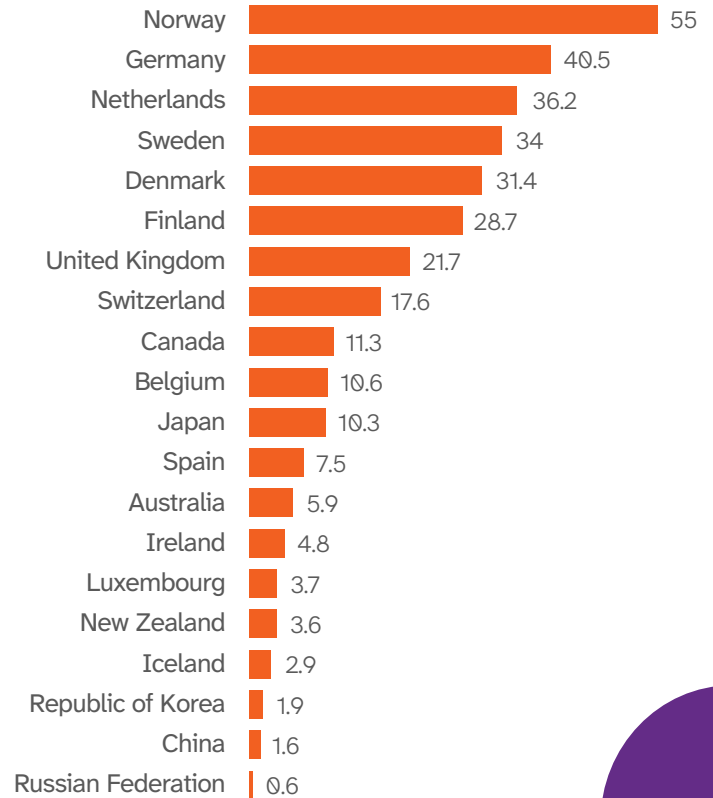

Regular resources, or core resources, are the bedrock of UNFPA's work. These funds are unrestricted, allowing flexibility to respond based on needs and priorities, with around 65 per cent of every dollar still going directly to programmes. No result, even those achieved through non-core funding, would be possible without core resources.

Core resources: Top 20 donors

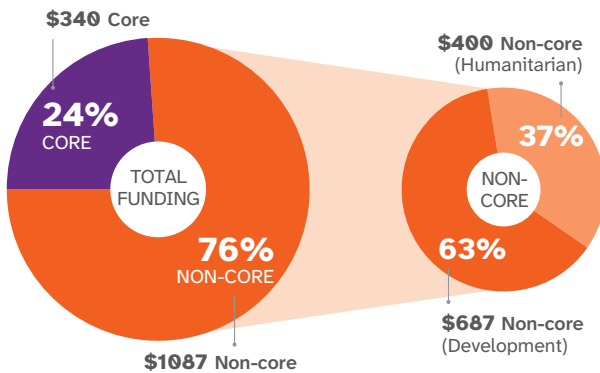

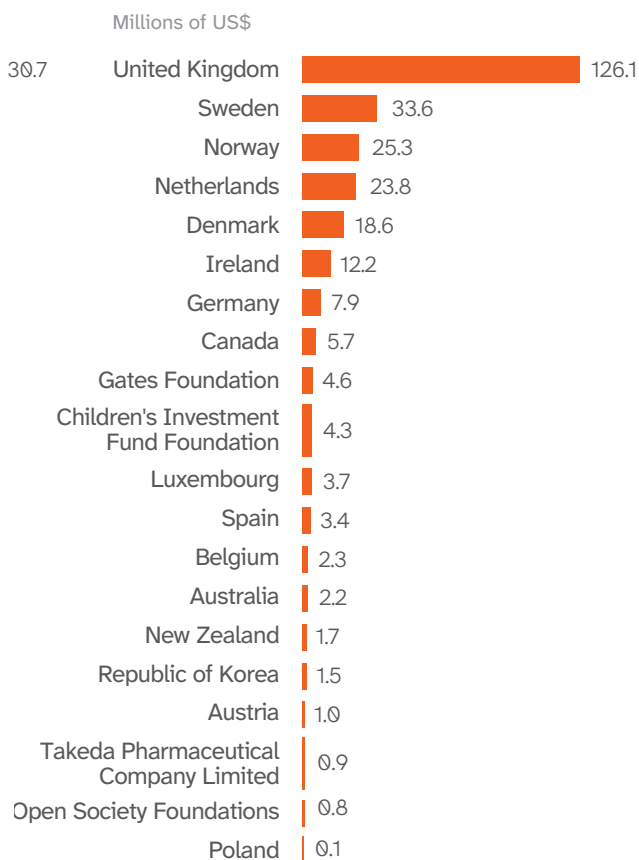

Key results (2022-2025)



295 million years of contraceptive protection provided for individuals and their partners.



66.1 million unintended pregnancies averted.



8.5 million safe deliveries assisted in crisis-affected countries.



142,000 maternal deaths averted.*



Over 50,000 women and girls with obstetric fistula received treatment.



23.6 million new sexually transmitted infections averted.*



540,000 new HIV infections averted.*



Over 24 million women and young people with disabilities benefited from services related to sexual and reproductive health, gender-based violence and harmful practices.



Over 28 million girls benefited from life skills and comprehensive sexuality education under the UNFPA-UNICEF joint programme of to end child, early and forced marriage.



820,000 girls saved from female genital mutilation.



70 per cent of the global population was counted in the 2020 census round.
